Description:

The project aims to assist Primary School teachers to increase the engagement of indigenous students by assisting them to become aware of, and more responsible for, their own learning. They will be mentored by educators with relevant experience and encouraged to observe and report on their observations of student engagement to determine the value-added to learning.
